THREE STRIKES AND YOU'RE OUT

Stop loving this evil world and all that it offers you, for when you love the world, you show that you do not have the love of the Father in you. For the world offers only the lust for physical pleasure, the lust for everything we see, and pride in our possessions. These are not from the Father. They are from this evil world. – 1 John 2:15-16 (NLT)

In baseball there is a hard and fast rule – three strikes, and you're out! The pitcher might throw curve balls, hard balls, knuckle balls, or any combination to get you to swing. If you swing and miss, that's a strike. If you swing and miss three times, your turn at bat is over with. I know this from personal experience. In Little League when I got up to bat everyone yelled, "Strike Out King," and that was from the guys on my own team!

Think of Satan as a talented pitcher. He knows exactly what type of pitch (temptation) to throw at us to get us to swing. But, unlike a baseball pitcher, he wants us to connect with the pitch and hit it out of the park. He has three basic temptations that he throws at us – the lust for physical pleasure; the lust for everything we see; and pride in our possessions. When we strike at these pitches we find that we are not out of the ball game, but, even worse, find ourselves living outside of God's will. Today let's make a vow to God that we're not going to swing, no matter how tempting Satan's pitches might be.
