

**Today's Sermon:** Are you ready for Resurrection? (Part 2)

### ***Are You A Disciple?***

Some just go along with the crowd and, if that gets you to pay attention to Jesus eventually, that is not so bad. But a true disciple will give a **lot** of attention to Jesus, and that means he or she will always want to be where Jesus is.

*Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life,  
John 6:66*

Paying proper attention to Jesus is a learning and growing experience. It is never *business as usual*, because there is nothing *usual* about our business. Even though the Word of God recognizes that there are babes in Christ and there are mature Christians, there is no recognition of a *super Christian* or even a *finished Christian*.

*Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:13, 14*
