## **Are Your Feet Dusty?**

And whatever town or village you enter, find out who is worthy in it and stay there until you depart. As you enter the house, greet it. And if the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it, but if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. And if anyone will not receive you or listen to your words, shake off the dust from your feet when you leave that house or town. Matthew 10:11-14

When Jesus sent His disciples into the towns and villages of their homeland, He did not do so lightly. He was keenly aware of the challenges that awaited them, and His instructions were full of ominous warnings as well as exciting encouragement. They would be literally getting a taste of what it was like to be Jesus in this world. In other words, they would carry powerful testimony to the folks as they healed the sick, drove out demons and raised the dead, but most of the folks would reject their testimony and want to kill them.

Jesus makes a distinction between houses that are worthy and houses that are unworthy. They are to greet every house but they are only to dispense peace to a house that is worthy. His command to them, when they encounter a house that is unworthy, is to actually "Let your peace return to you."

Isn't that interesting? I think there is some vital psychological advice there, and it matches our Lord's command to shake the dust off your feet. How many of us have dealt with rejection because of our testimony about Jesus? It stings us, especially when we know the one who rejects us. Unfortunately, the Lord's command to "greet" every house means we are to open ourselves up to the occupants and offer ourselves to them as servants of the LORD. We are to invest ourselves into the relationship.

Jesus knew, only too well, what sort of pain can come from that way of life, so He lovingly gave them His key to peace of mind. After all, it is not us being rejected but God Himself, and it is His acceptance that we seek, not the world's. We still need to be reminded to keep our peace but leave their dust.

This does not mean reject them, or castigate them, though warnings are appropriate; it does mean that we should move on and not castigate or reject ourselves. If you have shared your faith and been rejected, know that Jesus has got this. Do not exchange your peace for some old dust.
