Walk in The Light and Cast no Shadows.

This is the message, which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. 1 John 1:5

Light without shadows – is it possible? Aren't shadows a natural product of light? The only way you can avoid shadows is to eliminate all objects from its path, but God's Word tells us we must walk in the light. How can I walk in His light and not cast a shadow? If God wants His light to be pure, why would He invite me into it? Surely God would be better off to shine His light where there is no possibility of darkness. Nevertheless...

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light... 1 John 1:7a

There is a way to exist in His light apart from shadows; to experience light as He experiences light. That means we must be the light!

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light. Ephesians 5:8

So, we are either to be IN the light or IN THE WAY OF the light. We cannot simply bask in the light; we must burn with the glow of God's light...but how?

For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:6

God's Word has much to say about being united with God, in Christ. That is why baptism is so important. (Romans 6:1-4) Like moths, we are drawn to Jesus only to find that we cannot have His light and yet keep our own lives. But, too often we want nothing more than to flutter on our way and feel the warmth of His love on our wings as we go. Have you ever seen the shadows that such creatures can cast? A lantern in a tent at night is a welcome sight to the one who is out in the dark. But a small creature winging its way around that light can seem huge and grotesque and may well cause a person to take his chances with the dark. It is not enough to have enough light for my own vision. I must have enough light for the vision of the whole world. I must, like Jesus, love much more than just myself. The saints in light must understand this truth...

He who loves his brother abides in the light, and there is no cause for stumbling in him. 1 John 2:10
