# Flying With the Wings of the Gospel

I recently ran across a powerful little poem written by John Bunyan. It's one of the best statements I have ever heard about the difference between the Law of Moses and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Please read below to see how it relates.

"Run, John, run, the law commands, But gives us neither feet nor hands. Far better news the gospel brings: It bids us fly and gives us wings."

In other words, in the Old Covenant God gave commandments, but by and large did not give the divine procedure that would overcome the deadness and rebellion of the heart. But in the New Covenant, which God set up at the cross of Christ, God gives even harder commands, but He also gives the power we need to fulfill them through faith:

"that the ordinance of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For the mind of the flesh is death; but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace. Romans 8:4-6)

... remembering without ceasing your work of faith and labor of love and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, before our God and Father (1 Thessalonians 1:3)

To this end we also pray always for you, that our God may count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire of goodness and every work of faith, with power.." (2 Thessalonians 1:11)

We are duty-bound to run, even though our feet are willfully frozen in the ice of sin. We can't run in ourselves, and so the commands of the law condemn. And the gospel is not different in having no commands, no conditions. Flying is harder than running. With the gospel, however, we can not only fly, we can soar! Although this sounds difficult, with God all things are possible (Matthew 19:26). Some glad morning I'll gladly take my wings of the gospel and fly away to be with the Lord forever!
