My niece over in NE England sent me this picture yesterday, along with some comments which basically expressed frustration with the way the Church of England is trying to interest the locals to join them. Here is a sample:

Giving something up for Lent - where's that in the Bible? ...how to make people feel excluded and put off!! What a load of church-babble terminology. I can't ever imagine Jesus talking like that.

She makes a good point. If Jesus was among us again would we need to dress Him in special robes and organize special events to mark certain days? Do we need to embellish the cross with fine words and fine clothes and sophisticated activities? Paul showed some of that same frustration in his letters.

You are observing special days and months and seasons and years! I fear for you, that somehow I have wasted my efforts on you. Galatians 4:10-11

Jesus does not want us to complicate the gospel with our own design improvements no matter how well intended. The Cross is not just about one week of the year, it is about eternity. The LORD'S Supper (eucharist) is not a propaganda tool, used to impress the world occasionally. It is the ongoing nourishing of the Saints. It is good to remind ourselves how Jesus invites us:

"Come unto me, all you who labor, and I will give you rest."
