Fear Is Not Always a Bad Thing

In every province and in every city, wherever the edict of the king went, there was joy and gladness among the Jews, with feasting and celebrating. And many people of other nationalities became Jews because fear of the Jews had seized them. Esther 8:17

"We cannot pressure people." "Don't offend anyone." "Just live a good life and people will be converted as a result."

There is truth in all these statements, but there is also something lacking in all of them. Call it zeal or faith or commitment, but these statements could be made by any person to any other person without ruffling any feathers. The Lord's command to His apostles was not "Go into the world and make disciples of all nations without ruffling any feathers". The events that led up to the statement in Esther 8:17 were about as dramatic as any event in history. The birth of the church and the preaching of the gospel has been the ultimate adventure of all time. Christians are involved in nothing less than the rescue of earth's population from Satan's holocaust. Just like Mordecai, who refused to bow to the enemy, and Esther, who stood up for her people, we are called to live courageous lives by faith in Christ.

In Esther's day God's people were on the verge of extinction but look how the tables were changed! As a result of the courageous faith of one or two people the Jews went from being the fearful to the feared. This was a good fear, though, because many of those who feared the Jews became Jews! Fear is often beneficial because it restrains us from doing foolish or dangerous things. It is the normal response to the sight of an oncoming train when you are standing on the tracks. Nobody regrets that fear once they have dived off the track and escaped destruction. So it was with these people who converted out of fear. They saw the train coming and wanted to get out of the way. So it was, and is, with those who are baptized into Christ under the terms of the New Testament. They see God's judgment coming and they want to take shelter immediately. Each living soul must be warned of the judgment to come, but who will warn them? How can we convince them without ruffling their feathers? There are basic facts we need to face:

- 1. Though the world wants to eliminate the truth of God and therefore His people (Romans 1:18-20), it is they who will be destroyed in the end.
- 2. God's people will overcome the enemy.
- 3. When the world sees us overcoming Satan, the power of God will terrify them.
- 4. As a result, many will want to join us. That's a good thing!
