The Presence of God

In the book of Exodus, we read about the "presence of God." God's people encountered His presence:

- at the burning bush (Exodus 3-4),
- in the 10 plagues sent on the Egyptians (Exodus 7:11),
- crossing the Red Sea (Exodus 14),
- in the cloud and pillar of fire (Ex. 13),
- in the thunder, lightning, loud trumpet blast, smoke and fire at Mt. Sinai (Ex. 19),
- in the angel sent ahead of them (Exodus 23),
- in the ark of the Testimony-between the cherubim (Exodus 25:22),
- in the glow of Moses' face (Exodus 34:29-35) and
- as the completed tabernacle was filled with the Lord's glory (Exodus 40:34-38).

The presence of God was also felt in New Testament time. The prophet Isaiah used the name "Immanuel" to refer to the coming Son of God. That name means "God with us" (Mt. 1:23). The Hebrews writer referred to Jesus as "the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of His being." (Heb. 1:3).

What about you and me? I'm glad that God's presence was revealed to the Israelites and that Jesus personally came to the earth. But I'm very glad that you and I aren't left all alone. God's Holy Spirit lives in each and every one of His children today. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit cannot be discerned by physical, mental or emotional manifestations. But just like we "know" that God forgives our sins when we are baptized, we "know" that His presence is with us today! We know because of the promise of God (Acts 2:38; 5:32; 1 Corinthians 6:19, 20; Ephesians 1:13, 14).
