### How to Enjoy a Better Life:

- 1. It is important to distinguish between life in Christ and life on Earth.
  - a. Life on Earth is limited and cursed, but life in Christ is not. (Romans 8:2)
  - b. Life on Earth can be blessed (improved), but life in Christ cannot.
- 2. There is something that is better than life God's loving-kindness. (Psalm 63:3)
  - a. God's loving-kindness is only experienced when we have life in Christ.
  - b. In other words, life in Christ is better than life on Earth.
- 3. Jesus promised a better life in John 10:10. Politicians promise us a better life, but Jesus keeps His promises.
  - a. Life in Christ provides power to overcome the world. (John 16:33, 1 John 5:4)
  - b. Life in Christ involves working while we are on Earth. (1 Corinthians 15:58)
  - c. The Lord's promise for abundant living includes His promise to provide what we need for working effectively. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times; having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.
     (2 Corinthians 9:8)
  - d. Too often we exempt individual church members from being involved and active in the work of the LORD. Many seem to want to let others do the work for them, like a sort of spiritual welfare system.
- 4. Real Living Defined:
  - a. Not by taking from others (covetousness). We can take things from another and make them our own, but we cannot take another life and make it our own.
  - b. It is better to give than to receive. (Romans 12:1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Those who want to live a better life will die a better death.
