## Judgment in Matthew

Matthew records several of Jesus' warnings about judgment and he uses the phrase "Day of Judgment" often. In a lot of these verses it sounds like entire communities are going to be judged as separate units. In these days of political strife and turmoil we wonder how the U.S.A. will be judged.

I tell you the truth; it will be more bearable for Sodom and Gomorrah on the Day of Judgment than for that town.

Matthew 10:15

But I tell you, it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon on the Day of Judgment than

for you.

Matthew 11:22

But I tell you that it will be more bearable for Sodom on the Day of Judgment than for you."

Matthew 11:24

Jesus compares the gentiles of Sodom and Gomorrah with the Jews of Chorazin, Capernaum and Bethsaida and says that they will fare more favorably at the judgment. This is because the Son of God personally visited the Jews and performed miracles among them, and they still rejected Him.

Communities do take on a certain character, and some are worse than others, but we must remember that God still judges individuals based on whether they repent or not. Jesus makes that clear when He responds to the Pharisees charge that His miraculous power came from Satan.

But I tell you that men will have to give account on the Day of Judgment for every careless word they have spoken.

Matthew 12:36

Jesus goes on to use the men of Nineveh as an example of those who repented, and then He cites the Queen of the South as an individual who had the right attitude.

The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now one greater than Jonah is here.

Matthew 12:41

The Queen of the South will rise at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for she came from the ends of the earth to listen to Solomon's wisdom, and now one greater than Solomon is here.

Matthew 12:42

Paul explains the remnant concept in Romans (9:27; 11:5) which basically means that not all Jews are lost because of what Jews did to Jesus. Neither are all Gentiles saved because of those who repented. Jews who repent will be saved and so will Gentiles who repent. As for governments, God will go on judging them (raising them up and taking them down) until the Day of Judgment but then it is every man for himself. There is one group, however, that needs to be aware that God pays particular attention to them.

For it is time for judgment to begin with the family of God; and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who do not obey the gospel of God?
