If we spend time with God's Word, we will find a wonderful insight into what sort of attitudes we should have as Christians. The Bible is very clear and specific about what our attitude should be toward God, toward ourselves, toward our brethren and toward the world. Let's look at the attitude toward God this week.

ATTITUDES TOWARD GOD:

LOVE...

Jesus gives us a demanding standard, but then He also personally demonstrated how to love God.

Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." Matthew 22:37 Is that your attitude toward God?

FAITH AND TRUST...

The close connection between faith and love is seen all through the scriptures and is portrayed beautifully in the Hebrew word *hesed*. This word is sometimes translated *mercy* (Psalm 23:6) but usually conveys the idea of *covenant love* or *loyalty*. The New Testament conveys that idea also.

Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. Hebrews 11:1

THANKFULNESS...

Thankfulness is a beautiful attitude for anyone to adopt, but it certainly should adorn the life of a Christian who has been blessed with God's salvation. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. Colossians 3:17

And it would be good to remember God's attitude toward those who are ungrateful... The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them. For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse. For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Romans 1:18-21

Once people get to know you, they will basically remember your attitude. It is the same way with God. He has an attitude about my attitude.
