

Getting a handle on it Today's sermon: How is the Church?

First Snow

"Come now, let us reason together, says the LORD: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.

Isaiah 1:18

We call it the first snow, but we have seen it many times before. LORD willing we will see it many times more. But the truth is that there is no snow in Heaven, and this time on Earth is just a season. Here, our eyes watch for that first flake just as, LORD willing, we will eagerly watch for the first robin to arrive in springtime. If you are like me, you hope to be the first to announce, "I saw a robin just now!" So far the first place robin-spotting award has eluded me.

Today, looking at this early taste of the new season, I wonder if God looks out from Heaven to scan this field of living souls. I have no doubt that He is eagerly watching for each soul who stands on the threshold of forgiveness, moved by the Holy Spirit to obey God's Word. Then, emerging from the waters of baptism, having left corroding sin in that grave, God sees that soul fresh, pure and white as snow.

Does Jesus see this "snow" before His Father does? That is just a picture that I imagine in my mind, but God also gives us pictures to help us grasp His gracious working among us, like that picture of snow that illustrates how complete is the forgiveness of God. When we think of the purifying power of God's Word we should remember that this is no seasonal occurrence. To be united with Christ in His death, burial and resurrection through baptism (Romans 6:1-4) is to enjoy the first pure snow and the first red robin simultaneously – forever!
