Be Yourself for God!

There can be no empowerment of an individual unless they are properly equipped. The problem typically comes up when we attempt to equip another in what is not their passion.

In 1 Samuel 17:38-40 we find the account of David and Goliath. David was about to go out on the field to face the giant when King Saul offered him his royal armor. David "tried to walk" but could not because he was improperly equipped. "So David said to Saul, 'I cannot go with these for I have not tested them.' And David took them off." The young shepherd boy was a fighter with slings and stones, not with the armor of a king.

It certainly would have been a different outcome had David accepted being burdened with someone else's view of equipping.

Service in the church is similar.

If we attempt to equip a Mercy Giver with the passion of the Evangelist, failure is prone to occur. If we place the passion of the Servant upon the heart of the Teacher, burnout will likely result.


