At the end of May 2018, 515 young people (ages 8 to 15) gathered for the 2018 Scripps National Spelling Bee.

On the last day the field had narrowed to only two contestants: Naysa Modi (12) and Karthik Nemmani (14), both from Texas.

Naysa was given the word "bewusstseinslage," which she misspelled (it is a technical term from the field of psychology for "conscious mental states which cannot be associated with specific sensations or images; psychologydictionary.org).

Up next was Karthik Nemmani who correctly spelled the word given to him, the word that led to his being crowned the 2018 Spelling Bee champion, the word "koinonia" (<u>www.usatoday.com</u>).
