### How Is Your Inner Ear?

Ossicles are the tiny bones in the inner ear that help transmit vibration, which becomes intelligent sound. It is an amazing design. I remember when I was in the Navy undergoing training for flight orders an instructor told us that these were the culprits that caused ears to itch. I have never been able to verify that and I think he was just trying to make his presentation more amusing. Teachers learn to use graphic illustrations and figurative language to get their point across. Jesus did this with His own teaching when He taught in parables and used imagery like that of a camel going through the eye of a needle.

There is nothing wrong with illustrating when you are teaching, and in some ways, this might be viewed as falling into the category of catering to itching ears. The teacher says things that he or she knows will be eagerly received, things that appeal to the ears. These are thoughts that stimulate thinking. They may be quite fanciful, like the camel and the eye of a needle (Matthew 19:24), or they may be dramatic embellishments of reality, like the wise and foolish virgins who needed to keep their lamps supplied with oil (Mathew 25:1-13).

In 2 Timothy 4:3, 4 we read a warning about itching ears, however. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths.

This obviously goes beyond stimulating people to receive what you are saying. Paul's concern is that the hearers themselves will have already made up their minds about what they want to hear. The actual core message must be just right or else their ears will continue itching. It does not matter how you illustrate the truth because they have turned away from listening to the truth and their passions now lie elsewhere. The ears are desperately trying to satisfy the heart. In the same way a person who loves the truth is described as one who "hungers and thirsts for righteousness" (Matthew 5:6) Jesus promises these people that they will be "filled". If a person does not love the truth they still yearn to be filled and so they "wander off into myths." They need to find teachers who suit their passions because none of them can satisfy their hearts. They can listen to as many false teachers as they want but their ears will only itch more and more. They are never filled, so they never stop seeking... wandering ... itching. They have an itch that cannot be scratched.

Those of us who love the truth are easily filled. We understand that itching ears must be scratched from the inside. Only God's wisdom can do that.
