The Crux

The crux of the matter is another way of saying "the heart of the matter", or "the main thing." Crux is Latin for "cross"

When one utters the words "The Cross" nobody asks, "Which cross?" It is understood that, although thousands have died on crosses throughout history, "The Cross" refers to only one of those and that would be Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Son of Man and Son of God. Jesus is the crux of the matter, the main thing, the clue that unravels the mystery. But why is that true? When we consider Jesus as the crux of the matter, He confronts us with what has been described as "the paradox of paradise." That is the challenge of comprehending His divine nature, and it proves to be too much of a challenge for many people who consider themselves to be Christians. It was certainly a hard pill to swallow for the religious leaders of His day and here are two references that cut to the chase.

Therefore, the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God. John 5:18

The Jews answered him, "It is not for a good work that we are going to stone you but for blasphemy, because you, being a man, make yourself God." John 10:33

If you were accused of blasphemy for making yourself equal with God and were to endure the sufferings that Jesus suffered, how would you feel if the accusation was false? Wouldn't you be denying the charge? At any point in those proceedings that led to Jesus dying on the cross He could have called it all off by simply denying the charge that He was making Himself equal with God. Why did He keep silent? Because He knew the ultimate declaration of His deity would come through His resurrection from the dead.

(He) was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 1:4

The conclusion that Jesus was fathered by Almighty God is rejected by many people who prefer relating to Him only as "Son of Man." Sadly, they are the ones who blaspheme the Holy Spirit and for that there is no forgiveness. (Matthew 12:31) But for the cross, Jesus would have been just a man, and you and I would be without hope, condemned to suffer the fate of sinful man, cut off from God. But the crux of the matter, the truth, is that because of the cross we can now participate in sonship with God.

Romans 8:14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"
