Having Fun or Just Clowning Around?

Recently there has been a rash of disturbing reports dealing with clown appearances in several states. Many of us are disturbed by clowns at the best of times but these reports tell of clowns going out of their way to scare people. It is to the point where legitimate clowns are thinking twice before they don their costumes and cosmetics.

The most disturbing image for me is the report of clowns who just appear on a street and stand there. I mean, that is just weird, right? Clowns are supposed to move around energetically. Everything about them is exaggerated as they seek to get our attention and entertain us. They are supposed to be happy! A clown that just stands and stares at us is completely antithetical, bogus and just plain scary. This might be a form of identity theft, or perhaps identity abuse?

Do you know another recognized part of our culture that might be accused of something similar to this? I read an article recently that offered six words that are the six words a Christian never wants to hear. (There are actually eight words in the sentence but two are contractions.)

I DIDN'T KNOW YOU'RE A CHRISTIAN.

How would that feel?

Are there people who put on Christ but who do things that Christ would never do? Are there people who put on Christ but then just stand and stare as lost people go by? Jesus certainly had a lot to say about hypocrites. The Bible has a word for pretense which suggests someone cloaks themselves, and we use the expression "wearing a mask" to describe someone who is living a lie. Here is how Paul warns of "such people" in 2 Timothy 3:4, 5.

...treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people.

We did not don a grotesque costume when we put on Christ. We put on the very best of humanity, and that should make us appealing to our fellow man. We exhibit the fruit of the Spirit, not gestures of the circus. One of those fruits is joy that comes from being fruitful. Truly following Jesus is a feel-good way to be. Making a pretense of faith is frightening.
