Membership Has Its Privileges

"Now you are the body of Christ and members individually" 1 Corinthians 12:27

People join themselves to other people for all sorts of reasons, but the general principle behind all clubs and organizations is that there is strength in numbers. That is the benefit for the group, but what is the benefit for the individual? The individual needs to know that he or she enjoys special privileges that only those who are members of the group are eligible to enjoy. There is an unlimited assortment of groups that any of us could join, but we ask ourselves what it is that we put in and what it is that we get out of membership. There are many members of the Lord's church and they are spread all over the planet, but we are all in agreement about the LORD. We recognize the value of the privileges that He extends to the members of His Body.

When we come to the Table we celebrate His death and we will do so until He comes again. When He comes again, He will transform our lowly bodies to be like His glorious body and He will take us to the home of our Heavenly Father and, because we share in His Table here, we will share in His House for all eternity.

Membership has its privileges.

It is vital that people understand that membership is open to anyone who wants to be a Christian and who is willing to comply with the will of the LORD. The Bible tells us that these commands are not burdensome (1 John 5:3) and that means that God makes sure those membership qualifications can be met by anybody who wants to meet them. It is also vital to understand that if you are not a member then you are not eligible for the privileges. Heaven will not be your home and therefore you should not be at the Lord's Table now, but it is your choice. There is no way for me to eat the fare from the table at the White House. So far no president has brought the White House into the home of any of our citizens. There is no "take-away" White House menu. But God has invited everyone to His weekly feast. Some think that cheapens the celebration, but some of us are just amazed at the privileges of membership in the Body of Christ.
