Early Christmas Presents

This is our first Sunday together in this building, which we now own. No matter what we think about this tradition that is called Christmas, it is hard not to think about the timing of this wonderful gift that God has given to us. To use a phrase associated with this time of year, "Christmas has come early".

The events that have led us to this point all indicate that "God's hand is upon us", to use a biblical phrase. This phrase is found repeatedly in the books of Ezra and Nehemiah, as those two saints were involved in the rebuilding efforts in Jerusalem. They recognized that, if they were to see Jerusalem and the Temple built as a physical entity, God's hand needed to be upon them every step of the way. Even as he prepared to make the journey to Jerusalem to begin the work, Ezra had this to say:

Ezra 8:22: For I was ashamed to require of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, the hand of our God is upon all them for good that seek him; but his power and his wrath is against all them that forsake him.

Those words remind us of Romans 8:28: And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

We know from the scriptures that the rebuilding project did meet with much success, but ultimately the people took their eyes off God and Jerusalem was never to regain its former glory. We have a very graphic demonstration of this principle from the account of when Peter walked on water, then sank when he took his eyes off Jesus. (Matthew 14:28-30)

It is imperative that, as we open this early Christmas present, we do not take our eyes off the One who gave it to us.
