How Many Kinds of Wisdom?

The book of Proverbs has a lot to say about concepts such as wisdom, knowledge, prudence and discretion. Sometimes it seems hard to know where one of these words should be used, because they are all so similar. There is one verse in the book of Proverbs, however, that actually uses them all at once, and is basically giving the reader an insight into the versatility of wisdom.

"I, wisdom, dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge and discretion.

Proverbs 8:12

True wisdom comes from God. James compares earthly wisdom with heavenly wisdom in James 3:13-18. Earthly wisdom brings disorder and strife, but heavenly wisdom brings peace. Like love, wisdom is impossible for us to fully understand. Who can "define the divine"? Like God Himself, wisdom is many things at once, but it always looks up to God.

So, Wisdom is said to "dwell with prudence". Prudence is wisdom that looks ahead (Proverbs 14:15) and acts and speaks carefully so as to avoid problems and to preserve that which is good. The Hebrew word is also used to mean *crafty* or *shrewd*, and these terms can be quite negative. It is the word used to describe the serpent in Genesis 3:1.

Our verse says that knowledge and discretion are "found out" by wisdom. Deuteronomy 4:29 says that "if you seek the LORD you shall find HIM". Wisdom naturally seeks to attain knowledge and discretion, and wisdom naturally finds them. We might say that wisdom looks within.

Knowledge is wisdom that looks around and experiences life. This is natural and practical knowledge that comes through the senses. A good synonym would be familiarity, and so Adam "knew" his wife, Eve. (Genesis 4:1). But we must never forget that "fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge" (Proverbs 1:7). We cannot truly know or enjoy anything about life if we do not fear the One who created life.

Discretion is a word used to denote purpose, plan or device. It is often negative, as in Proverbs 12:2 "...the LORD condemns a man of wicked devices" – KJV. The woman of noble character, however, is said to "consider a field" for the purpose of buying it. This is wisdom that looks to do good.

So, wisdom will...

... look up to God with devotion... look ahead with caution... look within with faith... look around with joy and look to the good with hope.
