#### Buried in the Promised Land

Before Joseph died in Egypt he asked his brothers a very special favor. You can read about it in two places in the Bible.

Then Joseph said to his brothers, "I am about to die. But God will surely come to your aid and take you up out of this land to the land he promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." And Joseph made the sons of Israel swear an oath and said, "God will surely come to your aid, and then you must carry my bones up from this place." Genesis 50:24,25

By faith Joseph, when his end was near, spoke about the exodus of the Israelites from Egypt and gave instructions about his bones. Hebrews 11:22

You can read about that promise being fulfilled many years later when Joseph and his brothers were all long dead.

And Joseph's bones, which the Israelites had brought up from Egypt, were buried at Shechem in the tract of land that Jacob bought for a hundred pieces of silver from the sons of Hamor, the father of Shechem. This became the inheritance of Joseph's descendants. Joshua 24:32

This is a clear case of someone still speaking, though dead. You could say that Joseph's faith lived on in his bones. Joseph was concerned about one thing when he was alive – the will of God. And he was concerned about one thing in his death - the will of God. He did not want to be separated from God's people ever again. He was going to make sure that part of him made it to the Promised Land.

Superstition? Fanaticism? Insanity? The world has little respect for such devotion today, but God sure does. He calls it FAITH!

Are you so convicted by God's promise of a heavenly reward that you are making your plans, now, to be in the Promised Land? Have you committed your body to holy ground, even now while you are alive? Will those who live on after you have passed from this world be able to draw sustenance from your faith? Are you so united with God's purpose, and His people, that, knowing what it means to be lost, you cannot bear the thought of ever being separated from them again? Wouldn't it be wonderful to have your epitaph read something like this?

By faith (.....) offered God an acceptable sacrifice. By faith he/she was commended as a righteous person when God spoke well of his/her offerings. And by faith he/she still speaks, even though he/she is dead. Hebrews 11:4
