Should Christians Celebrate Christmas?

This is a good but thorny question that we deal with every year at this time. Here are some thoughts and some questions. I leave you to answer them for yourself.

- Should anyone celebrate Christmas?
- What do we mean by *celebrate*?
- What is Christmas?

Christmas = Biblical truth cloaked in pagan rituals.

- Biblical truth: God's incarnation via the birth of His son.
- Pagan rituals: Fixed on calendar; Physical decoration and gift giving, partying.
- Christmas for some is just a time of celebration with no particular attachment. Perhaps family gatherings are more meaningful but millions of non-Christians *celebrate* in some way.

Christmas is commonly defined as a *Christian festival*. That is wrong. It is a worldly festival that has capitalized on, and bastardized, the nativity. The Church has no authority, neither has it any need, to follow the culture. But must Christians ignore Christmas? Is there any positive effect on society? Do people really think about Jesus?

- Would it be better if there were no such thing as Christmas?
- Is Christmas an obstacle to the gospel, or an opportunity?
- Can a Christian participate in a worldly festival that has a distorted connection with Christ?

I make a distinction between the meeting place and the market place. We come together to break bread, not celebrate Christmas. Beyond that, we each must test ourselves regarding every aspect of our lives. How many routine activities are we involved in that have worldly connections and no biblical authority? Birthdays, anniversaries, Sports, TV, Internet...

Should Paul have gone to the Areopagus? (Acts 17:19-32) He became all things to all men that he might win some (1 Corinthians 9:22). That was not his excuse for indulging himself. It was his defense to those who maintained their personal piety by cutting themselves off from sinners. Were the scribes and pharisees right in accusing Jesus as one who receives sinners and eats with them? (Luke 15:2). Did Jesus violate His personal piety when He came in to this ugly, sinful world that was ruled by Satan?


- Ladies Class: This Tuesday, December 11th. Place TBA. Our lesson will be Day 3 of Lesson 7.
