## The Water Cycle

Niagara Falls is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World, and it is right here in New York State (with a bit in Canada (2)). I have visited more than once, and I can't help but wonder if the same molecules of water have produced that spectacle more than once. The water cycle calls rain from water vapor. If you have once lived in the flesh, and been called to Heaven, you will not come this way again. It is appointed for each of us to die once (Hebrew 9:27). And yet, there is a cycle to God's water of life which is His Holy Spirit (John 7:37-39). To be indwelt by the Spirit is to be called Heavenward. That means we must relinquish our hold on this world as God shines His light upon us. The more of ourselves that we give up, the more God can pour His life into this world. The flow is from Heaven and back again. As the Spirit flows, it refreshes and revitalizes. It provides habitat for all manner of sinner, teaching them to walk in the light and not in the dark, because our lives are just vapor after all (James 4:14).

Of course, none of this would make any sense whatsoever without the knowledge of Jesus. This dying, parched world cried out for Him and He came...the very precipitation of God, falling like dew, shining in the morning sun. Then, falling like death, hard and cruel and dark, waiting for morning to come again; and it came. Then, He ascended back to the clouds, back to the light, back to very Heaven. Then, He sent His Spirit to call us. So, we cry for Heaven, and Heaven calls for us.

There has been a lot of water under the bridge since Jesus walked on Earth.
