Therefore, eternal ruin awaits all those that "obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ"

(2 Thessalonians 1:8).

Whether one was a king on a throne or a peasant in the field, lived in a mansion on a hill or an empty flat on poverty's row, reclined on a bed of ivory or lay on a bed of clay, was wrapped in purple or clothed in rags was of no consequence when God passed over Egypt (Exodus 12:13). All that mattered was "Is the blood of the lamb on the door posts of my house?" When time gives way to eternity, the sole matter of human concern will be, "Is the blood of the Lamb on the doorposts of my soul?" Jesus Christ is God's exclusive cure for sin.

The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are.
