The Old Becomes New

It is a biblical promise that "all things are made new" (Revelation 21:5; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

We know that God is capable of making whatever He wants out of nothing, but He also chooses to "remake" things out of what already exists. I believe that is because He pronounced everything He made out of nothing as being "good" (Genesis 1:31). When faced with a choice of replacing or reforming what He has already made God is not willing to scrap any of His works. Even though sin has caused so much destruction among mankind, God's remedy is to heal mankind rather than destroy them and create a new population for Earth. We see that in His dealings with the Hebrews. In Numbers 14:12 God offered to destroy them and make another nation out of Moses. Moses dissuaded God from doing that because the Egyptians would think He was not able to do what He promised to do with the Hebrews (vv.13-16). Even when God finally judged the Hebrews for rebelling against Him, and offered His grace to all nations, He still built the Church on the foundation of the Jews. (Ephesians 2:17-22).

When dealing with traditions of men Jesus was treated as "the new kid on the block" and was soundly rejected by the status quo. It is an irony that, even though He has been doing it for thousands of years, God's work of recreation always makes Him look like the newcomer. This can be seen among the traditions of men that are called churches today. Have you noticed that those of us who just want to be Christians and who take seriously the Bible teachings about church and salvation often are looked upon as some strange new group?

When Paul was in Athens he was called to the Aereopagus to speak to the people and they asked him "May we know what this new teaching is that you are presenting?" (Acts 17:19)

Things have changed very little 2000 years later and again there is irony in the fact that by going back to the Bible to restore the original Church we become the new kids on the block. Those who trace their heritage back to recent movements of men are soon convinced that they are the gatekeepers of God's truth and do not much like this new idea of doing the things the old way. Many denominations with names that glorify men instead of Christ have found confidence in uniting under the banner of Evangelicalism. This is an 18th century movement and therefore has not been around anywhere near as long as the Church of Christ. Yet they usually look at us as being newcomers and are often afraid to even enter into meaningful discussion about our beliefs.

It has to be said that the true Church of Christ is comprised of souls who respond to God's eternal and original Word and who find constant, new joy from searching the scriptures, because they are God's eternal and original Word. How new is that?
