Reading: Isaiah 40:25-31

Some argue our planet is sick, burning Many are out in the streets protesting the lack of action on climate change. One thing that is noticeably absent in all the rhetoric...GOD. (I have to believe that many of those who are warning us may well have a belief in God)

Who gets to evaluate the planet? God gave Adam and Eve a perfect planet to look after, but they / we began to approach the world as though it was our gift to God (Genesis 1-3) God reminds Job that he was not around for the creation. (Job 38:1-18) For all of Job's integrity he had slipped into thinking he could debate the state of the world with God. Not so...(Job 34:14). Is this blasphemy?

Historical event that focuses on the blasphemy of discounting God's ability to take care of His own world. (Isaiah 36-37) Assyrians are belligerent (36:13-20*). God is not impressed (37:21-29)

Sennacherib sends his army to invade Judah and blasphemes God when threatening Hezekiah. In response to Hezekiah's prayer, the angel of the LORD destroys 185000 Assyrian soldiers. (37:36-38)

Nowadays it is a simple problem of dealing with the natural order.

Supernatural is rejected. God is blasphemed.

What is your planet like?

Who calls the shots? Me? Us? Them?

Whose word will the planet respond too? (Hebrews 1:1-4)

Does Jesus live on your planet? Is He King?

How does He treat the environment?

He controls winds and waves (walking on water)

He feeds His sheep on His word. (John 6:35)

If the gospel is true, then it is true that our sin has cursed the planet. How great is the news that God can restore vitality and hope to His creation! How? By forgiving Sin. (John 8:1-11)

John 7:37-39 If Jesus can cause rivers of water of life to flow from our hearts, meaning the Holy Spirit what does that say about my planet. Is it fit or is it sick?
