Have You Been Leavened?

When they went across the lake, the disciples forgot to take bread. "Be careful," Jesus said to them. "Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees." They discussed this among themselves and said, "It is because we didn't bring any bread."

Matthew 16:5-7

There are some scary things in this world and one of them is yeast (leaven). According to the scriptures yeast is not something to be taken lightly. It looks ordinary enough, but yeast is associated with an invisible force that causes spontaneous growth. Mix some yeast into bread dough and give it some time and a little warmth and you will see the visible effect of this invisible power; the dough actually increases in size.

The Israelites were forbidden to use leaven in their bread the night of their Exodus from Egypt as God did not want them to have to wait for the dough to rise. When Jesus warned about the yeast of the Pharisees the disciples took him to be talking about bread and were remorseful about forgetting to bring bread with them. Perhaps they expected to have to rely on bread supplied by the Pharisees and Sadducees as a result of their negligence.

Jesus corrected their thinking by explaining that He was talking about the teaching of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.

"How is it you don't understand that I was not talking to you about bread? But be on your quard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees."

Matthew 16:11

Teaching is a very powerful agent of transformation in this world and the Bible often uses the yeast metaphor to teach this concept (1 Corinthians 5:6). When the disciples heard the words of Jesus as he spoke of the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees they were actually being "leavened". That is, of course, if they understood and accepted the teaching of Jesus. Sometimes the process of leavening, like the process of planting seed, fails because conditions are not favorable. In this case, however, we read...

Then they understood that he was not telling them to guard against the yeast used in bread, but against the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Matthew 16:12

The disciples were being transformed by the teaching of the Lord. Jesus was preparing them to bring the yeast of the kingdom into the world (Matthew 13:33). It is important to understand the teaching about leavening. There is natural leavening and there is spiritual leavening. Spiritual leavening can be either through truth or through false teaching.
