Our MAGI Box project is underway! We are aiming for some time in mid-May to deliver the boxes to Mark Hatfield. Thank you for the money donations we have already received, and we ask you to prayerfully consider donating money toward the items we order and purchase as a church. This money will go toward the following:

- Plastic soap boxes and plastic toothbrush holders
- Flip-flops for all
- Boys' basketball 7" shorts
- Boys' T-shirts
- Girls' knit tops
- Underwear (2 each) for boys and girls
- Balls for each, jump ropes for girls and yo-yos for boys.
- 32-oz. plastic beakers

We also appreciate donations of the following hygiene items:

- Boys' black pocket combs
- Toothbrushes
