Sermon Outline: RIGHTEOUSNESS: IT'S A LOVE / HATE THING
Reading: Heb 1:1-9
"I did what I did not for reasons of hate. I hated no one"
Died: Nov 28 1994: May 10, 1994
Jesus enjoys gladness ( <b>Heb 1:9</b> ) because Herighteousness and hated He looked forward to joy after the cross (Heb 12:2); a joy that is different from just staying in Heaven.
Only God loves perfectly (God is love – 1 John 4:16) and that means He loves even those who hate Him (John 15:24, 25)
Perfect love endures hatred. Jesus endures the hatred of evildoers for the sake of those who love Him, ( <b>Hebrews 12:2 cf. 9:28, John 6:40</b> )
He will eventually come to destroy evil, however (Rev 6:10; 2 Thessalonians 1:5-8)
If you love righteousness you will hate evil and you will long for justice but vengeance is (Rom 12:19, Heb 12:29)
Paul has much to say about love / hate and evil / good in Romans.
Rom 3:8 And why not do evil that good may come? — As some people slanderously charge us with saying. Their condemnation is just.  Rom 7:19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing.  Rom 7:21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand.
Rom 12:9 Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is
good.  Rom 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.  Rom 14:16 So do not let what you regard as good be spoken of as evil.  Rom 16:19 For your obedience is known to all, so that I rejoice over you, but I want you to be wise as to what is good and innocent as to what is evil.
Read Micah 3:1 – 4:5
There is ugly language in chapter 3 about just how cruel evil can be. How would you like to have a son like? Chapter 4 has different language when God speaks as the Father of Jesus.
He does not just love righteousness and He does not just hate evil. If we love righteousness we will take a stand against evil. If we hate evil we will demonstrate righteousness. There is a special anointing of joy for such

people.
