Three priorities of God that should be our priorities:

- 1. Ministry of God's Word.
- 2. Unity of God's Spirit.
- 3. Sanctity of God's Name.

Jesus outlines these priorities when He prays in Gethsemane. (John 17)

1. Ministry of God's Word.

In Acts 6:1-4 The twelve apostles explain to the multitude of disciples that they need to devote themselves to the ministry of the Word

John 17:8 "For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me"

Where there is the ministry of the Word there will be...

2. Unity of the Spirit

In Ephesians 4:1-4, Paul is concerned that Christians demonstrate the kind of unity that will convince the world that Jesus is one with the Father.

John 17:22,23 "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."

Where there is unity of the Spirit there will also be...

3. Sanctity of the Name

Peter tells us we are to bring glory to God by declaring His praises. (1 Peter 2:9)

John 17:6 (KJV) "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word ... (17) "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. (18)"As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. (19) "And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.

If we are to bring glory to God we must have unity, and the only way we can succeed in maintaining unity is by being faithful to God's Word. So, once again, we see that the Word of God is the means by which we fulfill our ultimate priority of glorifying God.
