LOVE IS By Arthur Barry

Attributes of love from 1 Corinthians 13:4-7.

It is not irritable or resentful.

Love is not resentful. This is the way the English Standard and the Revised Standard versions of the Bible read. The KJV says "...thinketh no evil". You might be more familiar with the reading that says love "keeps no record of wrongs" (NIV). That seems to be more powerful, and we can actually visualize someone writing down every wrong deed that another person does. The idea is that we should refuse to think badly about a person. Mothers often love their children to a fault, meaning they refuse to acknowledge any wrong, or make excuses for bad behavior. God, however, definitely calls for correction, discipline and rebuking if necessary, and God Himself will hold us to account for what we have done (Romans 14:12). If God is love, how can He be keeping a record of what I do?

God ultimately judges us on whether we are faithful to Jesus. God acknowledges that we are imperfect, and that is why He sent Jesus to represent us. Our faith is a way of life that calls for the perfect behavior of Jesus Himself, but also provides a way of repentance when we fall short. Seeing as how we all fall short, none of us can judge another one of us. God can, and will, judge us, however, and at the time of judgment we apparently will be very much aware of just how gracious He has been to each one of us. Those who have been faithful will rejoice about that grace and those who have not been faithful will mourn about it. In the meantime, God is encouraging us all to "finish the race". He grants us repentance and furnishes us with the comfort of the Holy Spirit. Because of His love we can overcome our shortcomings, and because of our shortcomings we love Him more.

We are to be like Him in that regard, aren't we? But so often we hold grudges for things people have done to us. Worse than that we take a dislike to someone and, not only do we keep track of their mistakes, but nothing they do is right. Even when they do something positive it angers us, and it seems they should be punished for that. That is resentment. It is a disease that eats you alive, and I believe it is the disease that is eating Satan in his hatred of everything that God does. The incredible thing about Jesus is that He takes all of that hatred and still wants the best for us. He holds no grudges; He bears no resentment. Pride and resentment are twins in the same way that love and grace are twins.

We see a lot of the P & R twins in our world, and they get into the Church as well. They were there at Corinth. However, if we listen to, and obey, Jesus we will always make room for the L & G twins.
