And so God tells us to keep the confidence we had at the starting line and that is how we will make it to the finish line. Remember how real Jesus is and push on. Feel again the excitement and the hope and run harder. Drink in His love and power again and be refreshed.

It helps to know that the One who began us is the One who will finish us, and that He runs with us always. When you run the LORD's race you are always on the finish line when you line up on His starting line. So, keep the confidence you began with till the end...and RUN!
