WHERE DO SINS GO WHEN THEY ARE FORGIVEN? By Raymond Elliott

Where do our sins go when they are forgiven? That is a most difficult question. However, the word of God does offer us some understanding on this subject. Take for instance the passage found in Micah 7:19:

"He will again have compassion upon us: he will tread our iniquities under foot; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea."

Sin in this verse is regarded as a personal enemy which by God's sovereign grace will be entirely subdued. As God destroyed Pharaoh and his army in the Red Sea, so shall he cast our sins into the depths of the sea of forgiveness and forgetfulness (Exodus 15:4, 10). If you will observe, the Lord will cast our sins into the "depths of the sea," and not near the shore where they can be washed back again. In Psalms 103:12, we learn, "As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us."

In reference to the new covenant that God would make with Israel and Judah, the promise was made: "For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin will I remember no more" (Jeremiah 31:31-34: Hebrews 8:12; 10:17). Thus we learn that the Infinite Intelligence possesses the attribute of forgetting sins that are forgiven. To some degree we understand how this is possible. Loving parents have often forgotten as well as forgiven the mistakes and sins committed by their children. In perfection, our Heavenly Father forgives and forgets the sins of His penitent children (I John 1:7, 9).

My friends, if you have not had your sins blotted out by the blood of Christ, please, as a penitent believer, be immersed in His name in order to obtain His divine forgiveness (Acts 3:19; 2:38). And God who forgives will also in His mercy forget your transgressions.
