The following is a report that I posted on Oct 21, 2014:

The work in Sayre was just beginning in earnest and it involved a door-knocking campaign. The first day of the Valley Cities Church of Christ Campaign is complete.

There are six of us in teams of two. We were able to set up six Bible studies and will be hitting the streets again tomorrow. Temperatures have been just right, and the rain only teased us occasionally.

I want you to get a feel for what is happening here. One 80-year-old drove 1100 miles, on his own, to be a part of this, and shed tears because God blessed him to be here. One 70-year-old started his flight schedule at 4:00am to get into Scranton, where he rented a car to drive 3 hours into Sayre, because there are lost souls here, but there is also now a concerted effort to save them.

Sandy and I are the babes of the senior set at 66. Sandy brought some of her famous chili along and one of her equally famous apple pies. We enjoyed stanching our hunger and sharing our stories of the day. We wish you could all be here to savor this special moment. Then there are these two young-uns, one 16 and one 17. They flew in from Alaska to help Grandma and Grandpa. Don't even get me started talking about these two.
